ABOUT THE DIRECTORY

The San Francisco Department of Police Accountability created this directory to provide better, more open access to and information about civilian and police oversight agencies in California.

This Directory is a jumping off point for the oversight alliance's goal of providing common resources and effective tools for modern civilian oversight of law enforcement.

Civilian oversight agencies are essential to transparency and accountability in modern policing. Yet many complainants cannot even locate the appropriate agency where they should submit a complaint. This project was prompted by the Department of Police Accountability's receipt of numerous complaints about outside agencies, including out-of-state police departments, and even complaints from other countries. This is reflective of how difficult and confusing it can be for both complainants and oversight professionals find the appropriate oversight agency or complaint venue.

Across the 210 hours it took to do the research, editing, and graphic design, Department of Police Accountability employees were frequently reminded of not only the importance of the directory but also of civilian oversight of law enforcement in general. In most jurisdictions without civilian oversight, complaint forms and complaint processes were incredibly difficult to find on those occasions we were able to find them at all. Police departments that did have a complaint page often prefaced it with intimidating language requiring complainants to submit the complaint in person, discouraging complainant anonymity, describing invasive investigative procedures, and offering ambiguous warnings about the severity of the repercussions if anything in the complaint was found to be false.

The San Francisco Department of Police Accountability provides this resource to enable all people who have a complaint about law enforcement to find the proper agency and the best available contact information, to allow civilian oversight agencies to direct complaints to the proper agency, and for the civilian agencies to identify each other and build a foundation for greater cooperation and information sharing as we venture forward.

The board holds monthly public meetings to hear feedback from the community, engage with police leadership on issues of concern and make recommendations about new approaches.

The BART OIPA's mission is to provide an effective independent citizen oversight system that promotes integrity and encourages systemic change and improvement in the police services that the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) provides to the public by ensuring that internal police accountability system functions properly; that behavioral, procedural, and policy deficiencies are identified and appropriately addressed, including racial profiling and allegations of racially abusive treatment; and, that complaints are investigated through an objective and fair process for all parties involved. The system will analyze allegations of misconduct; utilize data to identify trends, including disciplinary outcomes and trends; recommend corrective action and or training; maintain confidentiality; make policy recommendations; and report regularly to the BART Board of Directors and the public. The essential community involvement component of the system shall be accomplished through the inclusion of a BART Police Citizen Review Board.

IPA was formed by Assembly Bill 1586, signed by the Governor of California in 2010 to provide effective, independent oversight of the BART Police Department (BPD) by ensuring that internal police accountability systems function properly, that behavioral, procedural and policy deficiencies are identified and appropriately addressed, and that complaints are investigated through an objective and fair process. The operation of OIPA and the scope of its duties are defined by the BART Citizen Oversight Model (Model). The Model also defines the role of the 11-member BART Police Citizen Review Board (BPCRB). The Model provides that OIPA shall, at all times, be totally independent. All investigations, findings, recommendations and requests made by OIPA reflect the views of OIPA alone. OIPA is, therefore, entirely independent of the BPD, but has been granted unfettered access to BPD reports and personnel records pursuant to the Model.

OIPA is staffed by BART employees who report directly to the elected Board of Directors (Board). OIPA does not report to the BART General Manager or to the Chief of the BPD and, as discussed above, OIPA remains totally independent under the terms of the Model.

The Police Accountability Board was created to:

- Promote public trust through independent, objective, civilian oversight of the Berkeley Police Department;
- Provide community participation in setting and reviewing Police Department policies, practices, and procedures; and
- Provide a means for prompt, impartial and fair investigation of complaints brought by members of the public against Berkeley Police officers.

The Police Accountability Board's primary powers and duties are to:

- Advise and make recommendations to the public, City Council, and City Manager regarding the operation of the Berkeley Police Department, including all written policies, practices, and procedures.
- Review and recommend for City Council approval all agreements, understandings, or policies relating to mutual aid, information sharing, cooperation and assistance between the Berkeley Police Department and all local, state and federal law enforcement, intelligence, and military agencies and private security organizations.
- Consider the findings and recommendations of the Director of Police Accountability regarding complaints filed by members of the public against sworn employees of the Police Department, to recommend if discipline is warranted when misconduct is found, and in certain cases of serious misconduct, recommend the level of discipline.
- Participate in the hiring of the Chief of Police.
- Access records of City Departments, compel attendance of sworn employees of the Police Department, and exercise the
 power of subpoena as necessary to carry out its functions.

The Citizen Police Complaint Commission (CPCC) is one of six chartered commissions established to provide feedback and input to the City Manager, Mayor, and City Council on specified matters. The CPCC investigates allegations of police misconduct and reviews the service provided by members of the Long Beach Police Department. Like all commissions, the CPCC provides a rewarding opportunity for Long Beach residents to be directly involved in serving our community. Commissioners provide a valuable insight into the community's perception of and experience with members of the Long Beach Police Department.

The CPCC is neither an advocate for the complainant nor for the police personnel. Their findings can result in the accused personnel being disciplined, trained or exonerated. The Commission cannot, however, recommend discipline or penalty. While the Commission does not set policy, its findings have resulted in policies being changed or clarified to best serve the community.

On January 12, 2016 the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors voted to implement a Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission with the mission to improve public transparency and accountability with respect to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. The Commission is comprised of nine members representing the Board, with four members of the Commission recommended by community and other affiliated groups. The cornerstone of the Commission's work is community engagement and such engagement is encouraged and valued. The Office of the Inspector General and its staff will work closely with the Commission and shall be accountable for investigations.

The Los Angeles County Office of Inspector General (OIG) was created by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors to monitor the activities of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's and Probation Departments.

Created by ordinance in 2014, the OIG reports to the Board of Supervisors as part of their duty to supervise the official conduct of County Officers under Government Code section 25303. Reports provided to Board of Supervisors are public reports.

In January 2016, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors created and implemented the Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission. OIG works closely with this Commission in fulfilling OIG's mission.

In 2018, the Board of Supervisors directed OIG to investigate safety concerns within the Los Angeles County Probation Department's juvenile camps and halls. Later in October 2019, the Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to create a civilian oversight commission over the Probation Department. Similarly, as with the Sheriff's Oversight Commission, this Commission will work closely with the OIG to accomplish its goals and objectives.

The mission of OIG is to promote constitutional policing and the fair and impartial administration of justice. OIG's scope includes matters relevant to the policies, procedures, practices, and operations of both departments. Investigations may include any unit within each respective Department including any employee both sworn and civilian, working in any capacity. OIG is primarily an Auditor/Monitor model type. OIG may examine and review many types of documents including agency concluded investigations to make recommendations based on agency policies and training. OIG on limited occasions conducted investigations when directed by the respective agencies or the LA County Board of Supervisors.

The Office of the Inspector General (OIG) is an independent entity established through a voter-approved amendment to the City Charter in 1995. The original duty of the OIG was to inspect, on behalf of the Police Commission, the LAPD's handling of complaints of employee misconduct, and to perform other duties as assigned by the Commission.

The 1998 Rampart incident, involving misconduct by numerous gang unit officers, triggered an effort for LAPD reform and significant strengthening of the OIG. Beginning in 2000, the OIG's new powers included the authority to initiate any audit or investigation of the LAPD without prior approval of the Police Commission, guaranteed access to all Department information and documents, and the power to subpoena a witness at will.

In 2001, the City entered into a Consent Decree with the U.S. Department of Justice. The Decree required the Department to reform its practices in nine major areas. The Federal Court appointed a monitor to work with the OIG in conducting oversight and evaluation of the Department's efforts to satisfy the Decree. Relying on OIG oversight, the court lifted the Decree in 2009 by substituting a Transition Agreement to govern the last phases of reform. In 2013, the court allowed withdrawal from the Transition Agreement because all objectives had been met, and the OIG then assumed full oversight of the Department.

The Office of Independent Review (OIR) assists the public and the Orange County Board of Supervisors through its oversight of five county agencies. Its work is zealously focused on addressing and preventing harm to the public and County whenever possible. On a day-to-day basis, the OIR scrutinizes policies, practices, and specific incidents that may reveal systemic issues so that it can work to address them. It accomplishes this by working with the agencies within its jurisdiction, the Board, and the public to increase transparency, facilitate accountability, and ensure compliance with applicable law and best practices.

The OIR and its work will always adhere to and reflect the following principles:

Independence: The OIR carries out its work free from improper interference, obstruction, or influence. Its fact-finding will be motivated by a zealous focus on understanding high-risk County practices, ensuring compliance with applicable law and best practices, and preventing harm to the public and the County whenever possible

Transparency and Accountability: Consistent with applicable laws, the OIR prioritizes the issuance of periodic and special reports, with the aim of contributing to the Board and public's understanding of the policies and practices of the County agencies it oversees.

Integrity: The OIR and its staff conduct its work in accordance with all applicable laws, codes of conduct, and oversight best practices.

Responsiveness: The OIR continuously communicates with the community, the Board, and relevant County agency staff, with a focus on ensuring that its work is reflective of their needs.

The mission of the Community Police Review Commission is to promote public confidence in the professionalism and accountability of the sworn staff of the Riverside Police Department (RPD). The CPRC accomplishes this mission by conducting an independent review of officer-involved death (OID) cases and citizen complaints. The CPRC or the CPRC Manager may request independent investigation services to obtain further information about OID's or complaints. The CPRC may recommend changes in RPD policy and maintains community relationships through continuous public outreach efforts.

The Mayor and City Council nominate and appoint all nine Commissioners of the CPRC. In order to fairly represent the city, that membership is distributed among all wards of the city. Commissioners serve four-year terms and may only serve two terms for a total of eight years. By ensuring an independent and thorough review of all OID and complaint cases brought before the Commission, the CPRC is able to advise the Mayor and City Council on all police and community relations issues. Case review findings and suggestions are also shared with the City Manager and Police Chief.

Although ensuring the Mayor and those mentioned above stay informed, the CPRC strives to make the greatest impact while serving the citizens of Riverside. The CPRC is tasked with ensuring good relations between the Riverside Police Officers and the community they serve. The Commission's efforts serve to increase public trust in the Riverside Police Department. It seeks to provide the public with assurance that any allegations of misconduct lodged against a sworn officer will be fairly and thoroughly reviewed.

Through public outreach efforts, the CPRC provides a forum whereby community members can express their opinions and seek answers about the Police Department. Complaints, concerns or suggestions can immediately be shared with the Police Chief and appropriate staff thereby improving the quality of service provided by the Police Department. In addition, the CPRC educates the public on the purpose of the Commission.

The primary function of the Office of Inspector General is to ensure the integrity of the citizen complaint process for all misconduct complaints regarding employees of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office. The Sacramento County Sheriff's Office Internal Affairs Bureau is the primary investigative body for all complaints of misconduct. However, the Inspector General will provide independent and objective review of those complaints to ensure they are conducted thoroughly, fairly, and judiciously.

The Inspector General may also:

- Serve as a community and complainant liaison.
- Track and monitor high profile or serious incidents and complaints to include officer involved shootings, use of force, and in-custody deaths.
- Audit investigations and conduct systemic reviews of the disciplinary system.
- Review departmental policies and procedures and make recommendations for improvement.
- Listen to and address public concerns about law enforcement and provide citizens the ability to file misconduct complaints through the Office of Inspector General.

The Citizens' Law Enforcement Review Board (CLERB) was established to receive, review and investigate citizen complaints filed against peace officers or custodial officers employed by the County in the Sheriff's Department or the Probation Department which allege: (A) use of excessive force; (B) discrimination or sexual harassment in respect to members of the public; (C) the improper discharge of firearms; (D) illegal search or seizure; (E) false arrest; (F) false reporting; (G) criminal conduct; or (H) misconduct.

CLERB also has the authority to investigate the death of any individual arising out of or in connection with actions of peace officers or custodial officers employed by the County in the Sheriff's Department or the Probation Department, arising out of the performance of official duties. Incidents involving the discharge of a firearm by peace officers or custodial officers employed by the County Sheriff's Department or the Probation Department. The use of force by peace officers or custodial officers employed by the County Sheriff's Department or the Probation Department or custodial officers employed by the County Sheriff's Department or the Probation Department or custodial officers employed by the County Sheriff's Department or the Probation Department resulting in great bodily injury. And the use of force by peace officers or custodial officers employed by the County Sheriff's Department or the Probation Department at protests or other events protected by the First Amendment.

Furthermore, CLERB has the ability to prepare reports on the results of any investigations conducted by CLERB in respect to the activities of peace officers or custodial officers, including recommendations relating to any trends in regard to employees involved in Complaints. Prepare an annual report summarizing the activities and recommendations of CLERB including the tracking and identification of trends in respect to all Complaints received and investigated during the reporting period. Review and make recommendations on policies and procedures of the Sheriff and the Chief Probation Officer. And annually inspect County adult detention facilities and annually file a report of such visitations together with pertinent recommendations.

The Commission on Police Practices:

- reviews and evaluates serious complaints brought by the public against officers of the Police Department of the City of San Diego;
- reviews all officer involved shootings and in-custody deaths; and
- reviews and evaluates the administration of discipline arising from sustained complaints

Subsequent to the review and evaluation process, the Board may choose to make policy and procedure recommendations to the Chief of Police.

The mission of the Department of Police Accountability is to promptly, fairly and impartially investigate complaints against San Francisco police officers, make policy recommendations regarding police practices, and conduct periodic audits of the San Francisco Police Department. Civilians who have never been police officers in San Francisco staff the Department of Police Accountability.

The Department of Police Accountability was originally the Office of Citizen Complaints which was created as a separate city department by an amendment to the San Francisco City Charter (section 4.127) in 1982 and placed under the direct supervision of the Police Commission. In 2016, an amendment to the San Francisco City Charter (section 4.136) renamed the Office of Citizen Complaints the Department of Police Accountability, removed the Department of Police Accountability from the police department's budget and provided to the Department of Police Accountability the power to conduct periodic audits of the San Francisco Police Department.

The Independent Office of Law Enforcement Review and Outreach (IOLERO) was established by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors in 2015. IOLERO is an independent, non-police county agency. IOLERO's mission is to strengthen the relationship between the Sheriff's Office and the community it serves. IOLERO's primary functions include reviewing complaints against the Sheriff's Office, community outreach and making policy recommendations to the Sheriff's Office.

One of IOLERO's primary missions is to engage the community in order to make sure you are aware of our work and to be informed about your viewpoints, concerns and experiences. Our Community Advisory Council (CAC), composed of volunteers from across Sonoma County, helps IOLERO carry out this mission. Our goal is to be present at a minimum of one community event per month.
